***"Blessed is the Man"***

In our Sunday morning Bible class study over the Sermon on the Mount, we have been discussing what are commonly called, "The Beatitudes". These beatitudes show how God wants very much to bless us as His children, if we will simply let Him do so. He promised to bless us with the Kingdom of heaven, comfort, inheriting the earth, being filled, mercy, seeing God and being called His children. How awesome are the blessings God wants to pour down on us.

There are other "beatitudes" in the Bible as well. The very first psalm begins with a beatitude of its own: *"Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night."* (Psalm 1:1-2)

This beatitude psalm begins with a negative. God will bless us when we are careful about the company we keep and the situations we put ourselves in. Do you see the progression from walking then standing and eventually sitting? The psalmist is reminding us that, although Satan is powerful and temptation is strong, we have a great deal of control the situations we find ourselves in. We think we can handle it. We think we are strong. We rationalize certain things in our minds. And before we know it, we are sitting in the very place we would never dream of being! Keeping our minds and actions pure and guarded against temptation is our responsibility.

He follows the negative with the positive. The blessed man will be the one whose delight is in the law of the Lord; the one who reads and meditates on God's word; the one who actively applies God's word to his life, not simply others'.

God is truly in the "blessing" business. He desires to make our lives better, But He won't force His blessings on us. We must take an active role in seeking and accepting God's goodness to us. So a word from the psalmist: Be careful about the situations you put yourself into and rely on God's word. Then you will be truly blessed.
