"Making Every Effort"

"5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; 6 and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; 7 and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. 8 For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ."(2 Peter 1:5-9)

"10 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, [a] make every effort to confirm your calling and election. For if you do these things, you will never stumble, 11 and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." (2 Peter 1:10-11)

"13 But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, where righteousness dwells. 14 So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, make every effort to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with him." (2 Peter 3:13-14)

As we read God's Word we begin to pick up on certain words and phrases in the different letters. Second Peter chapter one uses a phrase three times and is repeated in the last chapter. That phrase is "make every effort" to "giving due diligence" in other versions. The most important thing that I have found according do the definition of the word effort found in bluleterrrible.org that it means to be eagerly sincere, to be striving for, and to interest oneself most earnestly. The one definition that stands out today is to have that interest. We need to be more interested in wanting to know God and having a relationship with Him than any other human interest here under the sun. This requires effort and a want to know him. To do to this, we need to be in His Word by reading, studying, and meditating. We also need to be with the Lord's people to receive encouragement and spur one another on to good deeds in this world. We pray that we may know Him better.

That is Peter's desire in this letter. He points out the things we need to add to our faith in 2 Peter 1:5-7 so that we may not stumble (2 Peter 1:11) and await our rich welcome into the eternal kingdom. (2 Peter 1:11-12). He points out for us to make every effort to make our calling and election sure. Are you confident in the Lord today of your eternal destination? He also makes it very clear in 2 Peter 3:13-14 that we should make every effort considering His coming to be found spotless, blameless, and at peace with him. Are you at peace with the Lord today? Peter said himself in 2 Peter 1:15 he is making effort so that they will remember these things. So then, what can we take away from this? We should make every effort to add to our faith so that we will be effective and productive in the Lord. We should be making every effort to know who we are in Christ by confirming our call. We should be making every effort to rid of ourselves of sin and to be at peace with the Lord at his coming. Do you feel productive? Do you feel sure of your calling? Do you feel at peace with the Lord? Let us think and pray about these things. God bless, keep fired up, Mark.
