"Only A Few Find It"

As Jesus begins to conclude the Sermon on the Mount, He calls for a decision. He says, "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many enter though it. But small is the gate and narrow is the road that leads to life and only a few find it." (Matthew 7:13-14) That got me thinking. Why do only a few find the road to life?

It's not because the destination is not appealing. Who doesn't want life over destruction? It's not because the road is not well marked. There is no doubt or ambiguity as to what God wants from us. It's not because God only wants a few to find it: "For God so loved the world...". So why do only a few find it?

Some will not find it because they are too distracted. How many times have we missed a turn because of distractions or being preoccupied? Years ago when I was taking classes in Commerce, I missed the Brashear Rd. exit (my usual route). I then missed the Campbell Rd. exit (alternate route). Before I knew it I was in Greenville! I guess my mind was elsewhere. People become so busy and preoccupied with other things in life that they simply miss the road that leads to life.

Other will not find it because they are led astray by others. I once asked someone I trusted for directions to Spring Hill High School. I followed their directs perfectly and ended up at White Oak High School! The person did not intentionally mislead me (at least I don't think so), but I ended up at the wrong destination none the less. Jesus warned about false prophets who would promise the destination, but offer the wrong road (Matthew7:15-20).

Others will miss it because they rely on their own knowledge and judgment. There have been times where I have gotten lost because I was "sure" I knew the way. The Old Testament writer warned, "It is not within man to guide his own steps" (Jeremiah 10:23).

Whatever the reasons, the destination is the same: destruction. We must study God's word and listen to Him as He directs our steps to the path that leads to life. We want to be a part of the few who find it!
