"Unenforceable Laws"

Harry Emerson Fosdick wrote of those who, "yield obedience to unenforceable laws." Is seem to me that the true test of character is our willingness to obey principles that are unenforceable.

By unenforceable I do not mean to say that we can ignore these principles and get away with it. Ultimately we must pay; finally we reap what we sow (Galatians 6:7-8). The unenforceable laws are those which we can for a time ignore without being made to obey them. No one will force us to yield now. Our true attitude about the speed laws is determined not by how fast we drive when the state trooper is watching us, but by how fast we drive when he is not watching. Do we obey the law when it appears unenforceable?

Love for other people; the willingness to share and serve; concern for the lost; devotion to family and friends; the determination to honor God in the way we live and talk; the need to be good examples of faith and devotion are all unenforceable at the moment. There is no person who will now make us do what is right in these areas. The true indication of our spiritual character is our willingness to do right in these and many other important ways, not because we are being forced to do so, but because it is right to do so.

As Christians, we need to yield to the leading of God's will because it is right to do so. It is right when neither God nor man is forcing us to do so.

Jesus said, "But wisdom is proved right by her actions" (Matthew 11:19). Doing right always turns out to be the right thing to do. - Norman Miller
