HOREB: A Call To Service

It certainly got Moses' attention. That bush that was on fire but didn't burn up. As he goes over to it, God speaks to him. This is the first record we have of God speaking in 450 years. The Hebrews were enslaved in Egypt and now it was time to rescue them. I'm sure Moses was all for it. He may even have thought, "What took you so long?". But what God tells Moses next shocked him even more than the burning bush. God tells Moses that He has chosen *him* to go to Egypt, confront Pharaoh and lead the people out.

Moses begins to explain to God why he was not the right person for the job. And in a way, Moses had a point. He was a fugitive wanted for murder. His own people had lost respect for him. He had been a simple shepherd for the last 40 years. He was getting on in years. He claimed to be a poor public speaker.

But God still chose him. In God's eyes he was uniquely qualified. Isn't it interesting how God often chooses the seemingly unqualified to carry out His will? Gideon was hiding out when God called him. David was the least of Jesse's sons. Elisha was a simple farmer. Mary was a young girl. The four brothers were uneducated fishermen. Matthew was a disrespected tax-collector. Paul was a persecutor of the church. Timothy was a young untrained man. Yet God takes all of these and uses them for His purpose.

Make no mistake, God is calling you too into His service. Each of us is in a particular unique situation to serve God. Esther balked at approaching the king but Mordecai reminded her that perhaps God had placed her there at that place and that time to save her people. There are people you know that only you can reach with the Gospel. They won't listen to me. They won't listen to someone else. But God has put you in their lives to share the Good News with them. You have unique gifts and talents that God can use for His purpose if you'll be open to Him.

The question is not, "Has God called me?", He has. The question is, "Will I answer the call?", and we should.
