In Ephesians 3:17-19 Paul would say "...And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge-that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God." It is inherent in this fact the necessity for all of us to grow in our understanding of this love that we have received from the Father. Let us use the opportunities we have to be together throughout the week to be strengthened by His love. We can note this in Acts 19:17-19 "When this became known to the Jews and Greeks living in Ephesus, they were all seized with fear, and the name of the Lord Jesus was held in high honor. 18 Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed what they had done. 19 A number who had practiced sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly. When they calculated the value of the scrolls, the total came to fifty thousand drachmas. 20 In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power."

We can see in the two passages above the call we have to understand the power of love, how it can transform us, and how we can continue to grow in it. Paul would even say to the church in Philippi:

"And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God." Philippians 2:9-11

Remember that knowledge is not just for knowledge sake, knowledge of God should call us to love even more. Let us build up one another in love. "...knowledge puffs up while love builds up." (1 Cor. 8:1) God's love be with you, Keep fired up in the Lord. Mark White


THANKSGIVING FELLOWSHIP
