"The God of All Comfort"

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God." 2 Corinthians 1:3-4.

This is the way Paul begins his letter to the church in Corinth. Paul and the church were already undergoing certain hardships and persecutions because of their faith and he wanted to encourage them. Our present situation is not a persecution because of our faith, but Paul's words are none the less appropriate.

First, Paul reminds us that our God is a god of compassion and comfort. This would have been in stark contrast to the Greek and Roman concept of the "gods". Their version of gods was of cruel and vindictive beings always at odds with mankind. Our God is one who has done everything to reconcile mankind to Himself, even the sacrifice of His own Son. He is a caring God, full of compassion and comfort.

Secondly, Paul tells us that He blesses us with that compassion and comfort. He does not keep it to Himself. He showed His compassion by offering salvation. His is showing His compassion and patience by waiting for souls to be saved. He shows His comfort through His promises that reassure us in times of distress and tragedy. He shows His comfort through His Word and by His Spirit that dwells within us.

Thirdly, Paul reminds us that the comfort we have received from God is to be shared. Scripture tells us that we are to share God's love and mercy with others. But we also share His comfort. That is part of being a church family. As the words to the hymn says, "Sometimes we laugh together, sometimes we cry. Sometimes we share together heartaches and sighs.". God truly knew what He was doing when He created the church, the body, the family of God.

Keep safe and encourage and comfort one another until we can meet in person again!
