"The Right Clothes"

Several years ago, when we were still in the old auditorium, I had an embarrassing situation arise. It was summertime and I was mowing my lawn next door in shorts and a t-shirt. Meanwhile, there was a wedding going on at the church. At that time we had programmable thermostats at the church that were a bit complicated to override when needed. Someone came and told me I needed to come and turn the air conditioners on in the auditorium. It was already full of guests dressed nicely for the occasion and in I walk in my mowing attire. I had to go to the front of the auditorium in full view of everyone to set the thermostats. Needless to say, I was self-conscious and a little embarrassed. Maybe you've been in a similar situation where you were either underdressed or perhaps overdressed for the situation.

Paul reminds us in Colossians 3 that as Christians, we have "taken off" the old self of anger, rage, malice filthy language and lying. But we are not left spiritually naked. He says that we are to "clothe ourselves" with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. We are to forgive others just as Christ forgave us. "And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity."

In Galatians 3, Paul puts it this way, "You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ." When we clothe ourselves with Christ, we clothe ourselves with His attitudes and attributes which include kindness, forgiveness and love. What we wear says a lot about us. What we support, what we consider important, what we stand for. People should be able to look at us and see what we do and hear what we say and recognize that we have been clothed with Christ.

Before we go out each day, let us make sure that we are wearing the "right" clothes.
