MUTUALLY ENCOURAGED BY EACH OTHER'S FAITH

Praise God for the faith we have in Christ. Praise God that we are encouraged by the faith of others and that our faith also encourages others. Paul would say it this way when talking about mutual edification based on faith. He says in Romans 1:12 "that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith".

There are different levels that faith and encouragement are linked together. One level is hearing about the faith of a congregation serving the Lord in various ways. It is quite interesting when we can see the body of Christ serving the Lord both locally and globally. Romans 1:8 says "First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world." A great encouragement to others to hear of the faith of a congregation in the Lord. We can learn from each other as we hear about the faith of the Lord's body in different places. Paul would even indicate in 1 Thessalonians 1:6-10 how the message rang out from not only in Macedonia, but Achaia as well when He states "your faith in God has become known everywhere..."

Another level of faith is on a personal level that encourages us. Paul would write in Philemon verses 5-6 "because I hear about your love for all his holy people and your faith in the Lord Jesus. 6 I pray that your partnership with us in the faith may be effective in deepening your understanding of every good thing we share for the sake of Christ" The apostle John would also write of the faith of Gaius in 3 John verses 1-5. This brought about joy in the heart of John hearing about the faithfulness of Gaius. Remember that your faith can spur one another, encourage one another, and bring joy to others on both levels.

Understanding that our faith has an impact as a body and individual should call us to grow in our faithfulness with the Lord each day. In fact, may we serve the Lord with our various talents faithfully. May the works we do we do by our faith in Jesus Christ wanting to serve Him and glorify Him and the Father. We can understand on this level of faith that it is ever increasing. Paul wanted to grow and see the church continue to grow in faith. 1 Thessalonians 3:10 says "Night and day we pray most earnestly that we may see you again and supply what is lacking in your faith." May we pray for each other and may our lives be one that lives by faith so that others will be spurred on, encouraged, and filled with joy.

Thanks for your faith that has encouraged me; may my faith encourage you as well. May we all be mutually encouraged! **Mark White**
