“How Strange are You?”

We just finished 30 lessons on First Peter. When we began, I had no idea that we would spend that much time in such a short letter. However, I believe it was time well spent. From the beginning, we used as a theme, “Peter’s Travel Guide to Strangers in the World”. At least three times Peter alludes to the fact that we are strangers, aliens, travelers, pilgrims, sojourners, etc. He begins the letter by saying, “*To God’s elect, strangers in the world ...*” Further in chapter one he says, “*live your lives as strangers here in reverent fear.*” And then again in chapter two he says, “*Dear friends, I urge you as aliens and strangers in the world to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul.*” Paul echoed this thought when he said in Philipians, “*But our citizenship is in heaven.*”

We sing songs like, “This World is Not My Home” & “Here We Are But Straying Pilgrims”. But do we truly feel that way? Do we truly feel out of place here in this world? Or have we “assimilated” into the world’s culture? Have we adapted to the society around us? Do we no longer feel “strange”, but comfortable. I’m not a world traveler, but I have been to Mexico, Brazil, Cuba, Jamaica and England. In each of these places, while I may have felt safe, I would not say that I was comfortable. The language is different (yes, even in England!), the food is different, the customs are different; and as a result I was different! No matter how hard I tried to “blend in”, there was no denying the fact that I was a foreigner. I feel the same way even in parts of the U.S.!

However, if I stayed long enough, studied the language, immersed myself in the culture; talked, dressed, ate and acted like everyone else, I would begin to blend in. If I made friends and built relationships, eventually I would feel less and less like a stranger and at some point I would begin to be comfortable. That’s good if you are an operative of the CIA. But that is not good for us as Christians.

God has not called us to “blend in”. God has not called us to “assimilate”. God has not called us to be “covert”. God has not called us to become “comfortable”. He has called us to be “different”. He has called us to be “holy”. He has called us to “shine” as lights in the world. He has called us to be “strange”. As Christians, our speech should be strange. Our actions should be strange. Our values should be strange. Our attitude should be strange. So we ask ourselves the question: “*How strange am I?*”
