A great beginning to the church at Philippi

“One of those listening was a woman from the city of Thyatira named Lydia, a dealer in purple cloth. She was a worshiper of God. The Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul’s message. When she and the members of her household were baptized, she invited us to her home. “If you consider me a believer in the Lord,” she said, “come and stay at my house.” And she persuaded us.” Acts 16:14-15

The relationship that Paul had with the church in Philippi is notable. Paul was obeying the Macedonian call and the Lord directed him to the city of Philippi. When he decided to go to a place of prayer he encountered Lydia among the other women that were there and she responded to the gospel. She then invited them to her home. What a joyous occasion! Imagine the conversations. Further on in the chapter we see Paul and Silas in prison because of the preaching of the gospel and the Word of God gave us the opportunity to see the conversion of the Philippian jailer and his family at their house. After Paul and Silas were released where did they go? “they went to Lydia’s house, where they met with the brothers and sisters and encouraged them...” Acts 16:40

HARVEST TIME

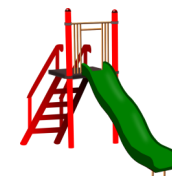
