"But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly to the end the confidence we had at first.' Hebrews 3:13-14

Satan's lies that make us believe that the hope we have is unfulfilled; that the Christian life is not worth it; that things would be easier if we followed the ways of the world.

The writer encourage the Christians of his day by reminding them of how much better, superior, greater a life in Christ is compared to anything this world has to offer. We must believe that. We must remember the promises that God has made to us. Promises that we may not see fulfilled now, but at the end of a faithful life. We must remember that the world has nothing to offer beyond this life.

Yes, it is worth it! Yes, we will hang on! Yes, we will encourage each other! And yes, we will share in the glory of God's own Son!
