God bless you as you strive to glorify the Lord in your lives. Our Sunday morning class in Philippians has challenged us to make this our goal. Here are some of the passages calling us to strive together:

Philippians 1:27 "Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel".

Philippians 2:1-5 "Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, 2 then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. 3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, 4 not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. 5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

Philippians 3:12-14 "Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. 13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."

Philippians 4:8-9 "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. 9 Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you."

As brothers and sisters in Christ: let us make it our goal to conduct our ways in a manner worthy of Christ at home, work, school, along with our family and friends. (1:27) We have been called to remember what Christ has done for us and that should be our motivation to do all we can for unity and to have the attitude of Christ in all circumstances. (2:1-5) The reason we do this is because we understand the goal we have must be found in Christ at His coming and for this we strain toward what is ahead and press on to the goal of Christ heavenward. May we keep our focus as a church family on that goal. (3:12-14) Paul would say remember to rejoice that our names are written in the book of life. He would say this because Euodia and Syntyche needed to be reminded that they were contending with others because of the gospel and not to be contending with each other about less matters. Above all, if we want to keep the right attitude and allow the peace of God to reign in us we must think on the things that are praiseworthy and put those things to practice just as Paul had mentioned in Philippians 4:8-9. May we be challenged by God's Word to strive and love with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Keep fired up!
