**FAMILY TIES**

The Church is the house of God (I Timothy 3:15). The word house here obviously means household or family. As Christians, we are "the children of God" (Romans 8:16). This makes us heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17). We are one with Christ in this great spiritual family.

The Bible says that "both he that sanctifies and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren" (Hebrews 2:11). Christ is the one who sanctifies. Christians are the ones who are sanctified. Christ and the Christian are "all of one" as the passage states. All of one, what? The answer, I think, is that we are all of one Father and so we share together with Christ in the one great family of God.

Notice that Christ is not ashamed to call us brethren. In Spite of his greatness, he is not ashamed to recognize us and identify with us in the family of God.

As Christians, we have established a one to one relationship with God through Christ. The Apostle John said that "truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ" (I John 1:3). This relationship that we have with the Father and with the Son is the basis of our Christianity. But we do not experience this relationship in isolation; therefore, our relationship with other Christians is vital to us. The Apostle John wrote about the fellowship that we have with God and the Son in the passage cited above. But he also wrote about the fellowship that we have with one another (I John 1:7).

It is essential that we nourish the bond of fellowship that we have with God and with Jesus. Our prayers, the worship services, the reading of scripture and every act of service strengthens that bond.

The bond that we share with other Christians must also be nourished. We are a part of a family (I Timothy 3:15). We are stones in a building (I Peter 2:5). We are members in the body (I Corinthians 12:14). We are in fact "members on of another" (Ephesians 4:25).

We have responsibility to each other which clearly forbid any attempt to go it alone with regard to the rest of the family. We are taught to love the brotherhood (I Petr 2:17). We are to "care on for another" (I Corinthians 12:25) (I Thessalonians 5:11).

No congregation should ever become a collection of strangers. We should not be anonymous worshippers. We must not be just casual acquaintances like the members of some civic club. We are a family under the Fatherhood of God. The family ties are important.

**PRAYING FOR THE SICK**

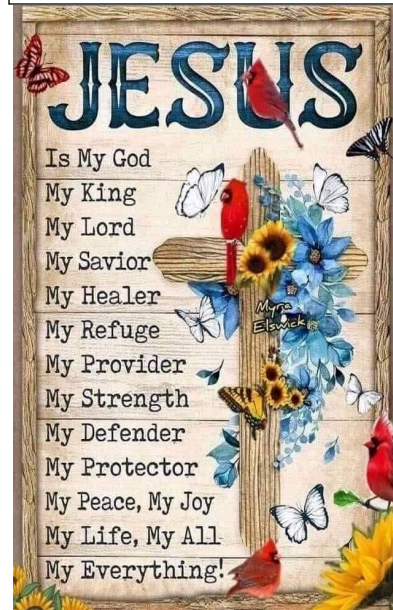
