In The Meantime

"Trust Me"

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust God, Trust Me also."

These are part of Jesus' words to His disciples in the upper room. Sounds simple: "Trust me". But how many lives have been ruined by those words? For many, they have been hurt so many times in the past by those they trusted, that trust is an almost impossible concept.

Our ability to trust is affected by how often and how deep we have been hurt. It is also affected by our personal experience with the one in who we place our trust. This is the point Jesus is making to His disciples and to us. "Trust me. Have I ever failed you?" The answer in an emphatic, "No!". Are there times in our lives when we feel as if God has failed us? Perhaps. Do we sometimes feel that God has not delivered on His promises to us? Maybe. Do we get confused and frustrated waiting on God to intervene as we think He should? Probably. But it is in those times that we need to remember the two foundational principles of our faith: God is and God loves me.

If we can trust that, (and we can!) we can begin to understand and interpret the events in our lives in a different way. We can realize that the problems we have with trusting God are with us, and not Him. That's why the scripture says, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:4-5)

God has never let us down. God has always kept His promises. God is faithful. That is why Jesus can say to us, "Trust Me!".
