"Blessed are the Peacemakers...

... for they will be called the children of God." Wow. What a powerful statement, especially in these times of turmoil and unrest. As we look at this particular "beatitude", it is important to note that Jesus said that it is the peace "makers" that will be blessed. Not the peace "lovers". Not the peace "seekers". Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others" (Philippians 2:3-4).

Let us all become peacemakers and be blessed by being called the children of God.
