## "What's Love Got To Do With It?"

These are the title words from a Tina Turner song in 1984. No, I don't know the song, but I do recall the title. The apostle John's answer to Tina's question is: "Everything!". Love has everything to do with it. We have come to that section in First John where he spends a great deal of time in an in-depth discussion on love. God's love for us, our love for God and our love for one another.

He first of all reminds us that God *is* love. Along with faithful, light, just, patient and others, love is one of the attributes that define God. Not that He loves. Not that He shows love. But rather, He *is* love. His very nature is love. John then explains that, "*this is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.*" This is a reminder that it is not our love for God that begins the whole salvation process, but it is God's love for us. It is His love for mankind that sent Jesus to the cross. And Paul tells us in Romans 5:8, "*God demonstrates His love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*" While we were still unlovable; while we were still enemies; while we were still stuck in the muck and mire of sin; while we were still condemned: Christ died for us.

John's main point is that it doesn't end there. Because of God's love for us, we must love one another. It's not an option. It's not a suggestion. It's a command. In fact John says that if you say you love God and don't love your brothers and sisters, you are a liar. Harsh words, but undeniable. John tells us that, "*anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen.*" John says that by showing our love for one another, love is made complete. Like a continuous circle connecting God's love to us and our love to one another. So, "What's love got to do with it?": Only EVERYTHING!

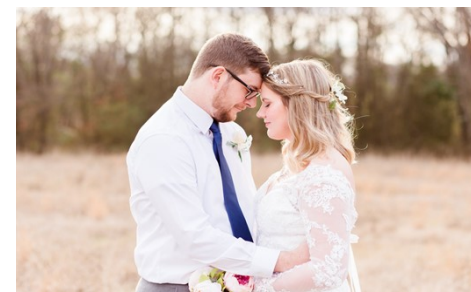
