SERVING IN THE LOCAL CHURCH

The Bible says that "the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved" (Acts 2:47). Church is another word for house or household of God as we learn from 1 Timothy 3:15. The household of God is his family. God is our Father (Matthew 6:9), and we, as Christians, are His children (Galatians 3:26-27).

The universal church is all of God's children wherever they are. But it is not possible to have all of God's children world-wide meeting together at one place and time. So, we have congregations or local units of God's people. In this sense the Bible speaks of the church in Antioch (Acts 13:1); in Ephesus (Acts 20:17); in Corinth (1 Corinthians 1:2).

All around the world there are local churches of God's people. The Lord adds us to His family, to the universal church. But we do join a local church or congregation. Paul, also called Saul, attempted "to join himself to the disciples" in Jerusalem (Acts 9:26).

It is essential that every Christian be part of a local congregation of God's people. It is in the local congregation that we worship, serve and make our own contribution to the work of God. The leaders of the local church should know who the members of that church are, and they should be able to depend upon us, as part of the local church, to help carry forth the work of God here and now.

We are called to serve. But as a practical matter we cannot serve in the universal world-wide church. So, we serve locally. All the people faithfully where they are is what ultimately gives strength to the universal church.

Just how dependable are we here and now where we live and serve?
