WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP?

Family Life Groups will meet this Sunday evening. There are three things that you can do to help this ministry grow in order to fulfill its purpose in helping us grow closer to one another and the Lord as well as inviting those around us in our community such as friends or relatives in order to reach out.

The first is to PRAY. Pray that the Lord will bless the time in the home of the brother or sister that will be hosting the family life group. Pray that the Lord be honored and glorified in your time together. Pray that the Lord will help you to be an encouragement to your brothers and sisters in Christ. Pray that the time of fellowship will help you grow in your bonds to one another in Christ. Acts 1:14a says "They all joined together constantly in prayer..." In fact, the word prayer in the New Testament is used more in Acts than any other book. It was a vital part of the church and is a vital part of the church today.

The second is to PARTICIPATE/YOUR PRESENCE. Your presence has more influence than you will ever know. Your presence encourages the person hosting the family life group as well as all the others who are present. You are valuable. Acts 5:42 says "Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah." Be it at the church building or house to house, let's use this time to proclaim the good news of Jesus. This leads us into a third area.

The third is to PREPARE. Prepare for your family life group. Listen attentively to the sermon on Sunday morning. Most of our discussion questions and Bible study in our groups are based upon the lesson that Sunday morning. Be sure to remember that the family life groups start at 6:00p.m. Prepare yourself to enjoy the time of fellowship. Be thinking of how you can encourage your family life group. Prepare to be blessed through your family life group time together. Remember Jesus is there. Matthew 18:20 "For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."
