## Faith in Action

*"But someone will say, 'You have faith, and I have deeds.' Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by what I do."* (James 2:18)

In this passage, the person who claims to have faith but who has no deeds is challenged to show that faith. The point is clearly made. Faith can be seen only as it expresses itself. The Bible teaches in the plainest possible language that, *"faith without deeds is dead."* (James 2:26)

We may claim faith in the absence of some action to how it. But it is an empty claim. Genuine faith, like genuine love, always does something to show that it is real. The Bible teaches that what really matters is *"faith expressing itself through love."* (Galatians 5:6)

The centurion whom Jesus commended showed, by the course of his action, that his faith was real. He came to Jesus seeking help. He was furthermore convinced that Jesus could heal his servant without ever going to his house. Concerning this man, Jesus said, *"I have not found so great a faith, no, not in Israel."* (Matthew 8:10)

The woman who made her way through the crowd just to touch the hem of the garment that Jesus wore thus showed her faith. It is no wonder that Jesus said to her, *"your faith has made you well."* (Matthew 9:22)

Hebrews chapter 11 is sometimes referred to as the Biblical hall of fame. This is so because so many of God's great people are mentioned in this chapter. They all had faith—faith strong enough to express. Abel had faith and offered a sacrifice to God (v.4). Enoch had faith and pleased God (vs. 5). By faith Noah built the ark (vs. 7). Abraham obeyed (vs. 8). And the list goes on and on. In each case, faith acted and so proved it was real.

We must be men and women of faith—faith strong enough to show by its actions that it is real. Remember, *"faith without deeds is dead"* (James 2:26). A dead faith is not a saving faith.
