Wrestling in Prayer

Colossians 1:6-7 *"In the same way, the gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the whole world—just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and truly understood God's grace. You learned it from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, [c] who is a faithful minister of Christ on our[d] behalf,"*

Praise God for how he worked in the life of Epaphras to take the gospel message to his people in Colossae. We can understand from the very first chapter of Colossians that he was very passionate about spreading the message of the gospel and that he transmitted the Word faithfully so that they truly understood God's grace. In the rest of chapter one and two we see Paul exalting Christ and the fulness that we receive in Christ. He also reminds us of them of the spiritual circumcision done by Christ in baptism. Colossians 2:11-12 clearly states *"In him you were also circumcised with a circumcision not performed by human hands. Your whole self ruled by the flesh[b] was put off when you were circumcised by[c] Christ, having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through your faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead."*

In chapters three and four he gives application of how we should live now that we have given our lives to the Lord and how we exalt Christ through our new life, new attitude, and how to treat one another in different relationships. Above all, letting *"the peace of Christ rule in your hearts"* Col. 3:15 Paul understood that they needed encouragement to continue faithfully and he ends the letter to encourage them by speaking of Epaphras once again. He will say in Colossians 4:12 *"Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured."* The idea of wrestling in prayer shows his determination to get in the ring. May we as the Lord servants get in the ring to pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ. As you read this, think of someone who is needing prayer right now and pray that they also may be able to stand firm in all the will of God, mature, and fully assured of their faith in Christ as we exalt Him as King of Kings and Lord of Lords in our own lives. 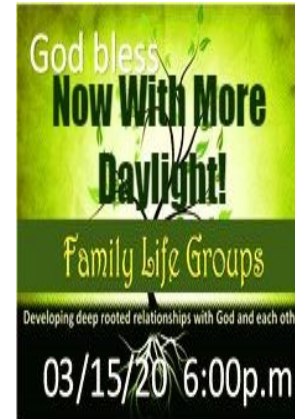
LADIES NIGHT OUT
