## In The Meantime

### "You Are Not Alone"

Being alone can be scary. It can also take its toll on a person emotionally, psychologically and even physically. Experts say that one of the most damaging effects of the pandemic is the feeling of isolation and loneliness. As Jesus has His last extended conversation with His friends He has told them that He was leaving. He anticipated that once gone, they would feel abandoned and alone. He reassures them and us that "in the meantime" we would not be alone.

He promises that He would continue to be with them, only not as before. He says, "abide in Me and I will abide in you". He knows that because of the deep relationship they have, they will be able to feel His presence in their lives. The same is true for us. The closer we get to Jesus the greater His presence in our lives.

He also promises the Holy Spirit, the Counselor, Comforter. In fact He tells them that this is one of the reasons He must go; so that the Spirit could come. The scriptures tell us that the Spirit is our Counselor to guide us and comfort us. We are also told that the Spirit is our guarantee or deposit on our salvation. God gives us the Spirit as an assurance that He will be faithful in His promise to take us to be with Him in Heaven. And we are assured that the Spirit helps us pray, even when we don't know how or what to pray for.

Jesus also stresses that the disciples will not be alone because they will have each other. How many times in this setting does He tell, remind, even command them to love one another? Just as God created marriage to fulfill a need within man for a special relationship, He also created the church, the body, the family to fulfill a spiritual need. The church is not optional. We need each other. This pandemic has helped to make it even clearer to me the need for God's people to meet together in worship, study and fellowship. The writer of Hebrews did not say, "Let us not stop meeting together" just so we could punch in and out of church. It is in meeting together that we "encourage one another", "spur one another on to love and good works", and help one another "hold unswervingly to the hope we profess". (Hebrews 10:19-25) So, in the meantime, we are not alone. Praise God!

This week Jesus says, "Don't Let Go!". See you Sunday!
