Colossians 4:12 "Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured."

What can we learn from Epaphras?

Paul says to the church in Colossae, where Epaphras was from, that he "is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus." Notice here that Epaphras is identified as a member of the body of Christ from Colossae. He knew where he was from and thought of them often in talking to Paul about them and praying for them. We as members of the church here in Daingerfield, are we talking about the good things the Lord is doing among us and praying for one another to grow in the Lord? One of his marks most identified was as a servant, may the mark we leave in this world be as light and salt as servants of Christ.
