Abraham's Shaky Faith

Abraham is a very interesting study. He is listed in Hebrews 11 as a member of the, "great cloud of witnesses" of faith. Paul uses him as the ultimate example of faith and righteousness (Romans 4). He is front and center to the Jews of both the past and present. If these references are all you see and hear about, you might get the idea that Abraham was almost super human in his faith in God. Yet, in our study on Sunday mornings, we have seen chinks in his "faith" armor. In fact, we have seen several large flaws.

When God initially calls Abraham to leave his family and go to Canaan, we see Abraham taking his father, brother and nephew with him and only going part way. We see Abraham not trusting in God to provide for him during the famine and taking his family to Egypt. In Egypt we see Abraham being dishonest to protect himself. All along the way, God is continually reassuring Abraham that He will fulfill all the promises He has made to him. Yet still Abraham continues to doubt. He questions if he will ever have an heir of his own. Eventually, as we saw this week, he and Sarah get tired of waiting on God and devise a plan to fulfill the promise of an heir on their own. Predictably this ends in disaster and has consequences that I believe still exist.

So what do we make of all this? How do we reconcile all these instances of doubt with the characterization of Abraham as the "Father of the Faithful"? It all comes back to the idea that even in his doubts and moments of weakness, Abraham still followed God. Not perfectly, but faithfully. We see this often in the psalms of David. In one breath David is questioning God, frustrated with God, even angry with God. But he always comes to the same conclusion: God is good and I will praise God.

I have often said to us that in our hours of darkness, confusion and doubt, remember two things: God is and God loves us. This will help us to always trust in God and doubt our doubts.

Eventually things look up for Abraham and we will see the great man of faith he becomes.
