# "What Kind Of Farmer are You?"

We recently began a study of Jesus' parables on Sunday evenings. We began with the wise and foolish builders and then discussed the Parable of the Sower found in Matthew 13. Luke 8 and Mark 4:1-20. Although I am not a farmer, there are some basic principles of "sowing" that are evident from Jesus' parable.

First of all, we are to sow the Word. This is expected of all of us as Christians. Jesus gave the great commission to preach the Gospel. In Acts 8, it says that the believers who were scattered preached the word wherever they went. We have the most important message the world has ever known. We should share this good news with everyone we can. It may be as simple as showing the kindness and love of Christ to others. It may be taking the opportunity tell others what God has done for you in your life. But no matter what form it takes, we are to be sowers of God's Word.

Secondly, we are not to be soil inspectors. We should not presume to judge someone's receptiveness by what we can see on the outside. We do not know their heart. We do not know all that is going on in their life at that moment. Jesus often had the biggest impact on those who would have seemed the least likely to listen: an outcast at a well, a tax-collector, a sinful woman. We also never know the impact sowing the seed will have down the line. Someone who is unreceptive at one point in their life, may be open to the Gospel later on. If we have sown the seed, the harvest may be reaped.

Thirdly, it would seem that we have a responsibility to try and cultivate the soil to help produce the most plentiful crop. Jesus spoke of the rocky and thorny soils that produced for a little while, but then for various reason the plant withered or was choked out. As a church family we need to be aware of each other. We need to look out for each other. We need to encourage each other. We must help each other develop roots within the family that will keep us strong in difficult times. We must help each other pull the weeds from our lives that threaten to choke out the most important thing.

Yes, we are all called to be farmers for God. Called to sow the seed. Called to cultivate the soil. Called to reap the harvest.

### HYMN FEST


