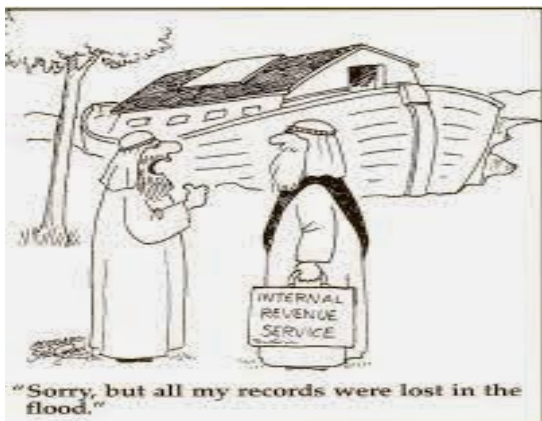
**ON THE WAY TO AFRICA**
