In pictures, guess the Bible verse.



Romans 12:11 "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord."

It is amazing how one verse in the Bible can speak volumes. This is how it is with most verses when we begin to meditate on God's Word. Paul is writing to the church in Rome and tells them earlier that they should live as living sacrifices, and that their minds should be renewed and transformed. He then begins to talk about how we have been given different gifts to be used to the glory of God and then admonishes them to be devoted to love, to cling to what is good, and in this verse to literally be Fired Up!

The phrase "never be lacking" means not to be sluggish. This word lack is also defined as not being slothful. We all know the speed of a sloth. Therefore, he is telling us not to be lazy or sluggish. He tells us that we should never be sluggish in zeal.

Zeal is defined as giving all diligence (enthusiastically), being earnest in striving after anything, intensity, or passion. A person can be zealous for a cause, a person, or an object. It is where Zealots get their name. Being zealous can be a good or bad thing, depending on what it is based on. He says about the Israelites in Romans 10:2 "For I can testify about them that they are zealous for God, but their zeal is not based on knowledge." He even gives a good illustration of this in Galatians 4:17-18 by saying "17 Those people are zealous to win you over, but for no good. What they want is to alienate you from us, so that you may have zeal for them. 18 It is fine to be zealous, provided the purpose is good, and to be so always, not just when I am with you." Thankfully, we know our zeal is based on knowing Christ and wanting to do His good, pleasing, perfect will in our lives.

He tells us "to keep our spiritual fervor", which the word for fervor is defined as "to boil with heat; be hot...generally used of water". So then, have you ever boiled water? How are we living our lives, hot or cold, or even worse lukewarm cited in Revelation? The Lord genuinely wants us to be passionate and earnest about our faith. A faith based on the knowledge of Jesus Christ and lived for Him daily. He gives us the key at the end of the verse for our zeal, our spiritual fervor which is "serving the Lord". Praise God all that we do is to this end. Let us keep fired up IN THE LORD for Him. -Mark White
