"Family God's Way"



This Sunday will bring to a conclusion our study of "Family God's Way". It will be our 16th lesson on the topic. I hope and pray that the time we have spent has been beneficial. We started off by understanding that family was God's idea. He created the first family and ordained marriage as the most sacred of all human relationships. The writer of Hebrews reminds us, "Marriage is to be honored by all". We discussed the purposes of marriage: companionship, physical intimacy, childbearing and as a demonstration of Christ's love for His church. We talked about preparing for marriage and how we should seek a spouse that will be a positive spiritual influence on us and our children. We saw that marriage has to be a commitment, based on sacrificial love and forever.

We looked at the foundational principles of marriage: love, forgiveness and trust. We discussed the roles within a family: husbands and fathers, wives and mothers, and children. We talked about how to keep our children SAFE by teaching them the right standard for their lives, involving them in Christian activity and fellowship and by our Christian example. We also discussed the importance of discipline and how it is the responsibility of parents to discipline their children. As James Dobson said, "Discipline is something we do *for* a child, not *to* a child".

Last week we began winding down by looking at how we get along with others by understanding human behavior. We will close this Sunday with a look at good communication and conflict resolution.

We live in a world where marriage and family, as God designed it, are far from "honored". It was my goal to reinforce what we should already know: that truly successful families are based on God's design and truths, not man's or society's thoughts. May God bless all our families as we look to Him for instruction and guidance.
