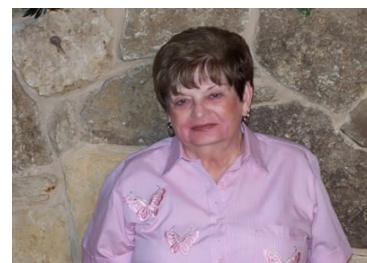


PRAYING FOR OUR SICK

MEN'S BUSINESS MEETING

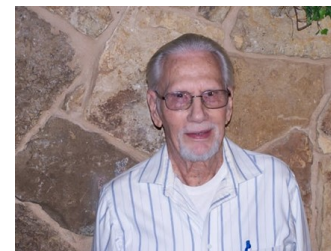
The men of the congregation will meet Sunday following evening worship in Room #3 for their monthly meeting.
