Fellowship With God

Fellowship is an important word in the New Testament. Acts 2:42 tells us that the early disciples devoted themselves to, "the fellowship". The Greek word translated "fellowship" is koinonia. It carries the idea of a deep intimate relationship. Often, we think of fellowship as something extra; or a byproduct of our Christianity. However, fellowship is an intentional part of our church family relationship.

In the first chapter of 1 John it is used to describe our relationship with God and with each other. The two are intertwined and inseparable. John tells us that our fellowship with God cannot be separated from how we live our lives. We cannot say that we have fellowship with God and not do what He says. It is impossible to have an intimate relationship with Him and live our lives contrary to His will. John goes on to say that if we have fellowship with God ("walking in the light"), then we also have fellowship with one another.

This fellowship is important for our spiritual growth and encouragement. God never intended for His children to face Satan and the difficulties of this life alone. We are a family, a community, a body of believers. We are dependent on one another, support one another, laugh and cry with one another. The most basic part of that fellowship is being here. It is in the time we spend together in worship, Bible study, prayer, etc. that our fellowship is strengthened. We need each other and we need to be with each other.

May God bless us as we grow in our fellowship with Him and our fellowship with each other.
