We will have Trunk/Treat here at the building on Sunday evening following services. We will have hot dogs as planned. Please bring the items you signed up for and don't forget the kids!

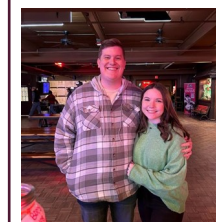
