### PRAY FOR ME

John says a short prayer when he is writing Gaius in 3 John 2 that says "Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well." It is such a simple verse but speaks much about prayer. When we think of it we can see three areas of prayer that we usually pray for others about in prayer requests that we may find in our bulletin, or that someone asks us to pray about in our life settings at work, home, or just out and about.

The first area we see John prays about for this dear brother in Christ is his health.
