Where No One

Once I stood in the night with my head bowed low in darkness as black as the sea In my heart felt alone and I cried oh Lord don't hide your face from me Hold my hand all the way every hour every day from here to the great unknown

**Stands** Alone

Take my hand let me stand where no one stands alone

Have you ever felt alone? Have you ever felt unworthy? Have you ever felt like no one is by your side? I am sure most of us may have felt this way sometimes in our lives. God has reassured us that He is with us, yet we struggle with our confidence in this at certain times in our lives. Take for instance God told Moses in Genesis 3:12 "I will be with you" after Moses has asked "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?". Even after this reassuring statement from God Himself Moses still was not sure at the moment and even thought of reasons why he should not be the one to go to Pharaoh. So, the question is, did Moses mature or grow in his faith. The answer is yes. How can we know?

We see this in the book of Joshua when the Lord tells him in Joshua 1:5-6 "...As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you or forsake you. Be strong and courageous..." We can deduct from this that Joshua had learned from Moses the importance of being with the Lord, trusting in the Lord, and the ability to become strong and courageous in the Lord. We learn throughout the book of Joshua that He understands and grows in his relationship with the Lord and when he is older he understands the importance of standing with the Lord and knowing that He is not alone. Joshua says one of the verses most quoted nowadays in 24:15 "as for me and my house we will serve the Lord". Joshua understood that even though all others forsook the Lord he and his house would not stand alone for they were on the Lord's side.

Perhaps even as a church we must remember we are not alone. The people of Israel felt all alone against the Philistines and Goliath, but praise God the young farm boy (whose older brothers even wanted him to go away) came and remembered that he and the nation were not alone. Even when Saul and the others said he was too young and should not go against this great warrior David remembered how the Lord had been with him before and that he would not be alone at this time. He says in 1 Samuel 17:14 "The LORD who rescued me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine." David knew he was not alone.

Wherever you are at this moment, reading this bulletin, remember that God is near. In fact, when Paul was talking to the people of Athens about the Unknown God he told them God was not far but was near. In fact, he would tell them that the Lord put us in set places and appointed times for an incredibly special purpose. To seek him for He is near. Acts 17:27 says "God did this so that they (in this case people from every nation) would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though He is not far from any of us." God is not far from you, you do not stand alone, you stand with the Lord. James 4:8 gives us this promise "Come near to God and he will come near to you". May our faith and confidence grow and mature in the Lord to the point that we remember that whatever the situation we find ourselves in we know that the Lord is with us. Keep fired up, Mark
