***Be Careful Not To Drift***

*“But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin’s deceitfulness. We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly to the end the confidence we had at first.”*

*Hebrews 3:13-14*

One of the ways the writer of Hebrews encourages his readers, and us, is by warnings. I remember Norman Miller saying, “There is as much love in a warning as there is in a promise.” That is very true. Hebrews 2:1 says, “We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.” If you are in a boat or plane, drifting off course can have serious consequences. It can lead to tragedy. The same is true spiritually as well. If we drift from God, His word and His church, there will be terrible consequences. We must guard against drifting.

Sunday morning I mentioned some “Principles of Drifting”:

- Drifting Requires No Effort. If we do nothing to strengthen our relationship with God, we will by nature drift. We need to spend time reading His word, praying and fellowshiping with His people.

- Drifting is An Unconscious Process. It can happen without us even realizing it. It may seem like everything is alright and before we recognize it, we’ve drifted far from God.

- We Never Drift Upstream. The currents of this world and our society will never take us closer to God. They will only carry us farther away.

- Drifting is Dangerous to Others. We rarely drift away by ourselves. Parents take their children with them. Church leaders can take whole congregations with them.

- Drifting Ends In Disaster. It might be a terrible shipwreck or simply drifting off never to be heard from again. Either way, drifting can be eternally disastrous.

So we have been warned. We will encourage one another not to drift away from the salvation we have been so greatly blessed with.
