Giving Thanks to God

Colossians 3:15-17 "15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. **And be thankful.** 16 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God **with gratitude in your hearts.** 17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, **giving thanks** to God the Father through him."

These verses speak volumes about how we are to live in Christ. There are two questions that come to me from these verses. The first is "What/Who is ruling my heart?" and the second is "Am I being thankful?."

The scripture says that we should allow our hearts to be ruled by the peace of Christ and that the message of Christ should dwell among us. We are to be at peace with each other because of what the Lord has done for us. In fact, in verse fourteen it says over all of the virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity. We are the body of Christ, and He is our peace. May we have peace reign among us as the family of God. Our hearts also must dwell on the message of Christ. We have the opportunity to learn from the Lord in His Word and the opportunity to teach one another His Word with all wisdom in so many ways. Even our songs we sing are teaching us to dwell upon the message of Christ. This is the importance of being together to spur one another on.

If we allow these two areas of our heart to be molded we cannot help but be thankful. Three times in this small section of Scripture it says to be thankful and show gratitude in our hearts. Gratitude for the peace we have in Christ, thankfulness for the message of Christ, and above all giving thanks to God the Father through Christ in word or deed. A way to do this is to say "Praise God for this opportunity! Or Thank you God for this opportunity!" When someone says something to us thanking us, take the opportunity to give the glory to God. In doing these two things happen; the first is that God receives the glory and the second is that person will see it is not about you but about God. So, two questions for you today "Is the peace of God ruling my heart? What can I give thanks and praise to God about today? God bless and keep fired up in the Lord, Mark
