SOUTHEAST FLORIDA CHURCH OF CHRIST

- BILINGUAL SERVICES IN PORTUGUESE-ENGLISH:
 - We continue meeting for our bilingual worship services every Sunday evening from 6:00 to 8:00 at the Clubhouse in Boca Raton.
 - We have maintained an average of 15-25 people every week. There's also a handful of people that connect with us via Facebook Live.
 - Many visitors and Maikon's English students have attended services with us at least once. Several have come more than once.
 - Junior continues to develop our yearly theme "My Life's Purpose." In the month of May he preached about "God's Mission" and in June about "The Spiritual Gifts."
 - We celebrated Mothers' Day in May and Fathers' Day in June. For both special services we had a presentation from the kids (a little song they sang to the parents) and a gift handmade by them. The church also gave the parents a small present and we shared a special coffee break after the services.






HOSPITALITY AND SERVICE:
