God bless you as you continually strive to do His good, pleasing, perfect will. May the Lord bless us as a congregation as we continually hold up the Word of God and our prayers for one another. Second, Paul is encouraged by the faith of Philemon and desires that Philemon continues to grow in his faith. Paul notes how people had heard of Philemon's faithfulness to the call of the Lord. The idea of being together is very much stressed when Paul says to Philemon that he is praying for Philemon's faith to continue to deepen to understand every good thing that we have in Christ Jesus. Paul even mentions the word partnership. Do we believe we are partners (sharers) in the faith together? May our faith and love grow in Christ and for one another daily to ascertain to be the family of God that is refreshed by one another.

Third, let us cover each other with prayer. We can see the letters that Paul writes how he prayed for the Lord's holy people wherever they may be as a church family and many times individually as in the case of Philemon. What can we do? Get out your church directory, dedicate some time daily to pray for one family per day and pray for the body of Christ (your church family) daily that we may remember that we are not alone and that we are in this together! Let's accomplish the great Commission, Keep fired up in the Lord! Mark White
