Lord, help me not to fall prey.

In the study of James, we learn from Chapter three the danger of the tongue and how it impacts things; Such as a small rudder that steers the large ship, or as a small spark that sets a great forest on fire. He goes on to say how the tongue is a deadly poison and if unbridled sets one's life on a course for hell. Strong words? Yes. Needed words? Certainly. He goes on to encourage and exhort us to use our tongues in a way that will praise God. He would say that we should use our tongues to praise God, using the example of fresh and salt water to reflect that there are two different types that are produced. Which kind of heart do we want to produce? One that flows from the heart that comes out as cursing human beings or a heart that comes from the overflow and praises. We know the answer. We want to use our tongues in a way to glorify God, yet perhaps we all have struggled at some time or another with our tongue.

Proverbs warns us of the use of the tongue and the power of gossip:

Proverbs 16:28 A perverse person stirs up conflict, and a gossip separates close friends.

Proverbs 18:8 The words of a gossip are like choice morsels; they go down to the inmost parts

Proverbs 20:19 A gossip betrays a confidence; so avoid anyone who talks too much

Proverbs 26:20 Without wood a fire goes out; without a gossip a quarrel dies down

Proverbs 26:22 The words of a gossip are like choice morsels; they go down to the inmost parts

Here is a quote I found from an article on crosswalk about gossip "They visit me as if they were my friends, but all the while they gather gossip, and when they leave, they spread it everywhere. All who hate me whisper about me, imagining the worst." (crosswalk.com) Many times we form opinions, thoughts, and make judgments when we listen to gossip. And many times if we are not careful that keeps us from getting to know someone. Have you ever felt anyone looking at you differently? Or when you walk by they look the other way all the time, or they will even try to avoid you? Perhaps the person who does this has fallen prey to gossip about you. What can you do then? Pray for that person, pray that they may have courage to even tell their friends to stop gossiping, treat them as you would like to be treated, and pray to the Lord, and He will lift you up in due time.
