"Jesus Replaces the Bar"

We have seen in our study of Jesus' "Sermon on the Mount" that Jesus is challenging His listeners and us. He is challenging us to be "Different". Different in the way we think. Different in the way we talk. Different in the way we treat others. Different in the way we view religion. He wants us to be different from the world and even different from certain religious thoughts. He told His listeners that they should be different even from their religious leaders. The key verse in the sermon in Matthew 5:20, where Jesus says, "Unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you certainly will not enter the kingdom of heaven."

The Pharisees were all about appearances. All about looking good and looking the part of righteousness. It didn't matter what was in their hearts, as long as they dotted every "i" and crossed every "t" of the Law. They were proud, arrogant and self-righteous. The problem with being "self-righteous" is that we can never truly be righteous on our own. We can never do enough good deeds, attend enough church services, feed enough starving children, give enough money to make ourselves righteousness. It is only through our relationship with Christ that we become truly righteous .

Last Sunday we began the section of the sermon where Jesus tries to get us to understand that it is about the heart and mind as much as it is about actions. He replaces the bar to where God intended it to be all along. It's not enough to not murder, we shouldn't hate. It's not enough not to commit adultery, we shouldn't lust. It's not enough to legally divorce, we should stay married. It's not enough to tell the truth sometimes, we should always be truthful. It's not enough to love your friends, we should love our enemies as well.

Wow! What a high bar! But this is what Jesus has called us to. And this is the "different" Jesus wants in our lives.

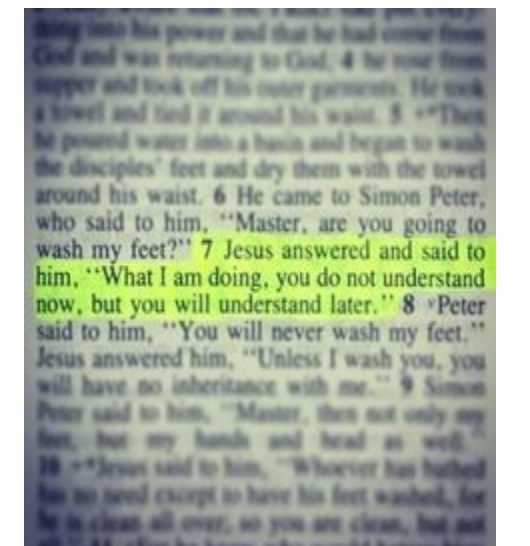
