IN THE MEANTIME

"Do As You're Told"

We have been in the upper room that last night Jesus had with His disciples. We've heard Him tell them that He was going away, but would come again. We have listened as He shared with them and us how we should live, "in the meantime". He has offered words of comfort: "Don't be afraid", "Trust Me", and "You are not alone". And we saw as He also gave them words of warnings: "Don't Let go".

Jesus also warned us to, "Get Along". Throughout this last extended discussion, Jesus returned to the theme of "love one another". He knew that once He was gone, they would need each other to make it through the "in the meantime". And so do we. That is why God established the church. That is why we are told over and over to encourage one another. That is why the writer of Hebrews warns us not to give up meeting together. We are stronger collectively that we are individually. Just as the herd is stronger than the lone animal. Together they are able to fend off the attacking lion, but apart they are vulnerable.

Jesus also warned us to, "Do as we are told". Jesus said, "*You are my friends if you do what I command.*" (John 15:14). Jesus is pretty clear that our continued relationship with Him is based on our obeying. Not that we are perfect, but that we are striving to please and serve Him. That we are not deliberately, continually and rebelliously disobeying His commands. We live in a world that wants to have its cake and eat it too. Any in our society recognize the need for Jesus and acknowledge God, but still wants to continue living their own lives, regardless of the teachings of the Bible. Jesus doesn't agree. He said, "*If you obey My commands, you will remain in My love*" (John 15:10).

As Norman told us, "There is as much love in a warning as there is in a blessing." As we wait for the return of Jesus, in the meantime, let us never let go, get along and do what we're told.

This Sunday we begin to look at the words of encouragement Jesus offers us.
