"I was one way and now I am another, and what happened in between was Him"

That is a simple statement (said in a series called "The Chosen") that speaks volumes about what Jesus can do in the life of any person by the power of the gospel message. We see it in the Scriptures many times stated:

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come:[a] The old has gone, the new is here!" (2 Cor. 5:17)

"9 Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices 10 and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator." (Col. 3:9-10)

"11 In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. 12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. 13 Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness. 14 For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace." (Rm. 6:11=14)

"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." (Gal. 2:20)

"9 Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor [g]homosexuals, 10 nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor those habitually drunk, nor verbal abusers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God. 11 Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and [h]in the Spirit of our God". 1 Cor. 6:8-12

We see many of the sins listed above in 1st Corinthians being said today in this world that you were just meant to be that way regarding sexuality as well as other sins. This passage does not say that. This passage of scripture says that is what some were, but now they had been washed, sanctified, and justified in Jesus. Do not let the world influence you to believe that there is no hope for change of sinful behavior. The gospel offers that hope. But we must not allow our thinking to be clouded and influenced by worldly thinking. Eph. 4:17 says "So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking" (I was just born this way kind of thinking). Instead of just focusing on the sinful things noted in the 1st Corinthians 6; focus on where it says that is what some of you were, that simple statement gives us hope that just as was said in the title of this piece of writing is still true. "I was one way and now I am another, and what happened in between was Him (Jesus)." Can you make that statement about your life? Pray for those struggling and still captive to sin that they may hear the forgiveness offered in Christ and then can say just as Galatians 2:20 says "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. 
