

It seems like an odd development. Israel had crossed over Jordan. They had defeated Jericho and after a brief setback, defeated Ai. Now they turn north and camp in the region of Shechem, between two mountains: Mt. Gerizim and Mt. Ebal. Why this pause in the military action? It was because God, through Moses had told them to do this. Deuteronomy 26:16-27:13 details what was to take place there. They were to build pillars and coat them with plaster and write the law in them. They were to build an altar. And then they were to divide the people: 6 tribes on one mountain and six on the other. Those on Mt. Gerizim were to recite blessings God promised the people. Those on Mt. Ebal were to recite curses that would follow if they didn't obey God's law. Joshua 8:30-35 describes the fulfillment of this event.

What was the significance of this? Why would God insist they go through this ceremony so early into the conquest of the land? God made it clear that He had chosen them from all the other nations to be His people. Now He wanted them to know what their responsibilities were if they were to continue to receive His blessings. The same is true with us. God chose us through Jesus Christ to be His people. His grace freely given and not earned. But the New Testament makes it clear that since now we are His people, we have a responsibility to live like His people. To be holy, blameless, different from the world around us. He wants to continue to bless us on into eternity. However, if we choose to disobey and not follow His Will, just like Israel, the results will be curses.

So we stand in the valley of Shechem. We have the choice between the blessings of Gerizim or the curses of Ebal. Seems an obvious choice, but let us not act as Israel did and choose Ebal. This week's lesson will come from Exodus 19-20. See you Sunday on the mountain!


