"Bad Habit"

"Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is his body, and since we have a great high priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spar one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

The fourth of the five "let us" statements found in Hebrews 10 is actually a negative. It says, "Let us not give up meeting together as some are in the habit of doing." We don't know why some had made a habit of not meeting with the brothers and sisters. I would guess their excuses are not much different than those today: Too busy, too tired, preacher is boring (not here of course!), don't get anything out of it, and any number of others. But in these verses, we truly get the sense of why God created the church and wants His people to meet together.

Obviously we come together to worship God and remember the sacrifice of Jesus through the Lord's supper. That should, in and of itself, make us desire to be here. We should long for the opportunity to praise God and show our gratitude for all that He has done for us. But it is more than that. Out time together is not just about us and God. It's about each other. It's about helping one another. Together we encourage one another to draw near to God, to hold unswervingly to our hope. Together we spur each other on to love and good deeds. We cannot do these things if we are not together. God didn't just want us to punch a time clock. He intended for our time together to be valuable. And it is.

Just being here is important. Just seeing an auditorium or classroom full of brothers and sisters who have the same hope, the same faith, the same struggles, is encouraging. You are important to all of us! And you being here is important to all of us. So let us never get into the habit of not meeting together!
