“Living and Active”

The writer of Hebrews says, *“For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.”* Hebrews 4:12-13. There are those in our world who would disagree with the description of God’s word as alive and active. In fact, they would claim that the Bible is an outdated, antiquated, irrelevant book. This kind of thinking can only come from ignorance or an agenda. No one can open-mindedly read the Bible and not see its relevance for us today.

Does our world not need more “love one another”? Is not, “Do to others what you would have them do to you”, relevant in our society? Would our families and communities and schools be better places in the fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness and self-control) filled them? God’s word is a message of hope, redemption, salvation, peace, purpose, grace and love. Are these not the very things our world seeks so diligently in all kinds of other ways? In fact, Paul tells Timothy that, *“All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”* 2 Timothy 3:16-17. God’s word thoroughly, completely, totally equips us for all that life has to offer.

But while God’s word is alive and active constantly and forever, it is only alive and active in our lives if we allow it to be. James reminds us not to be hearers of he word only, *“but do what it says.”* Jesus said the one who builds on the firm foundation is the one who hears His words, and, *“puts them into practice.”* Studying and meditating on God’s word is a good start, but following what it says is where it becomes alive and active.

May we never fall into the trap of believing that God’s word is irrelevant. May we always allow God’s word to strengthen and encourage us.
