THE DRAWING POWER

I confess freely to being something less than an avid sports fan. For this reason, if you see me at an athletic event, you may safely conclude that I have merely shown up. I likely will not have been drawn there by the events of the game.

Jesus said, "But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself" (John 12:32). He said this to signify the kind of death that he would die. There is a force about the cross that constrains. The power of the love demonstrated there draws us. The apostle Paul wrote that "Christ's love compels us" (2Corinthians 5:14). "But God demonstrates his love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). "We love because he first loved us"(1 John 4:19).

I understand that a person can just show up at an athletic event. I have done that. I also understand that it is possible for people merely to show up where religion is involved. But I also understand that the true motive in Christianity is love. And it is the love of God that draws and compels us.

It is also true that if I show up often enough at some special sporting event I may learn later to love that sport and be drawn to it by an intrinsic love of it. I am not in the business of trying to identify those who have shown up religiously as opposed to those who have been drawn. It may well be that many of those who showed up later learned to respond to the love of the cross. But one thing is clear -true conversion does demand that we be drawn by love and that we not merely show up.

Some of the old time preachers use to say that the gospel is the instrument that God uses to operate on the heart of a person. If the love shown in the gospel message does not reach us, we cannot be reached.

We are not in danger of hearing too much about love. After all "God is Love" (1 John 4:8).

Finally, it is essential that I ask myself this question: Am I drawn or do I merely show up?
