In The Meantime

"Don't Be Afraid"

We recently started a study of Jesus' last words to His disciples in John 13-17. He is preparing them for His departure. He understands their confusion, disappointment, frustration and fear. He reassures them that He will return; but what are they to do "in the meantime"? He offers them words of comfort, warning, encouragement and caution.

Jesus tells them, "don't let your hearts be troubled, don't be afraid". On the surface the command to "not be afraid" seems a little condescending. Making light of someone's fears only seems to exacerbate the problem. If I'm standing looking over a cliff, gripped with fear of heights and you tell me "don't be afraid", you are not helping! You have only added guilt and possibly anger to my already frayed emotions.

However, Jesus did not just say, "don't be afraid". He also offered solutions to the fear. In these chapters, He offers promises that will help us through those times in life when we are afraid. He reminds us that He is coming again to take us to be with Him. He pledges to send the Comforter to guide us. He says that He will remain in us if we remain in Him. He guarantees the Father's ultimate protection. And, He promises to give us His peace to comfort us.

Like the father in the pool reaching coxing his child to jump He holds out His arms and says, "Don't be afraid, I've got you." Jesus is telling us that yes, there will be fearful times in our lives, but don't be afraid, because God has our backs!

As David wrote in the beloved Psalm, "Yea though I walk through the valley of the shadow if death, I will fear no evil, for Thou are with me. Thy rod and Thy staff, they comfort me."

"Don't be afraid". A command with the promises to support it.
