"The Lord is My Shepherd"

"The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.

*He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters,
He restores my soul.*

He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

*Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil,
for You are with me; Your rod and staff, they comfort me.*

*You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my
head with oil; my cup overflows.*

*Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in
the house of the Lord forever." "*

Psalm 23

Six short verses that have come to have such meaning to so many people over the years. I mentioned Sunday that we often think of David writing this psalm as a young man perhaps sitting on a hillside as he watched over the sheep in his care. However, most scholars agree that this was more likely written much later in David's life as he looked back over God's protection and care. Yes, he drew on his experience as a shepherd himself, but now, older, wiser and with a closer relationship to God, he is comforted by reflecting on all that God had done for him.

Like David, there will be times of green pastures and quiet waters in our lives. In those moments, we must not forget to praise God and appreciate these times. Why? Because the valleys are coming. Notice that as David describes the "valley" he switches person in the pronoun he uses to describe God. Up until verse 4, he uses 3rd person and refers to God as "He". After describing the valley of the shadow of death, he begins to refer to God in the 2nd person, as "You". Perhaps because it is in the valleys that our relationship with God truly grows. It is in the valleys that we learn the real meaning of faith, trust and dependence. It is in the valleys that we can confidently say, "The Lord is MY shepherd!".
