“In The Meantime” You’ve Been Chosen

This Sunday we will return to our study of Jesus’ final extensive conversation with His disciples found in John 13-17. We’ve looked at His words of comfort and words of warning and are currently discussing His words of encouragement. Jesus makes the astounding statement to His disciples and to us, “I chose you” (15:16). Doesn’t it make you feel good to be chosen for something significant? And it should make you feel both humbled and amazed that God has chosen you. Peter reminds us that we are a “chosen people” (1 Peter 2:9).

It is important to realize that God has not chosen us based on our own goodness, worth or abilities. Peter and at least 3 of the other disciples were simple fishermen. Matthew was a tax-collector, and the others had such humble pasts that we don’t even know much about them. God chose us because He chose to choose us (I know, but it makes sense!). In the Old Testament, the prophets often remind Israel that God did not choose them because they were the greatest nation around. He choose them in spite of all their imperfections to be His people. Paul tells us that God demonstrates His love for us, “*in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us*” (Romans 5:8).

It is also important to remember that it is “in Christ” that we are chosen. Ephesians 1:4 tells us, “*For He chose us in Him (Christ) before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in His sight*”. God has chose all those who are in Christ to be His people. This means that even though it was God’s choice, we have a responsibility to accept or reject being chosen. Often, Israel would reject God’s authority and leadership which led to sever consequences.

Lastly, it is important to remember that God has chosen each of us for a purpose. As I read the writings of Paul, it has become apparent to me that the one thing that amazed him was not so much that God saved, but that God used him. That God had a purpose for him even after he had persecuted the church. God didn’t just save us to save us. He saved us to use us in His kingdom. No matter who you are or what you have done, God can use you.

Yes, it’s great to be chosen. But how great is it to know we have been chosen by Almighty God Himself; and chosen for a purpose!
