## "Now, Where Were We?"

Before we were so rudely interrupted by COVID, we had been looking at the *Sermon on the Mount* on Sunday mornings. I thought it might do us some good to review before we started back again this Sunday.

This sermon from Jesus is the longest single sermon recorded in the Gospels. It is found in Matthew chapters 5-7. It was heard by a large crowd gathered on a hillside. It was a crowd of ordinary people, curious about the one they had heard so much about. This was Jesus' moment to shine. The moment to announce His arrival. The moment to announce His agenda. I am sure His words were far from what the majority expected.

Jesus began by telling the people how to be blessed by God. Be poor in spirit, mourn, be meek, starve for righteousness, show mercy, be pure in heart, be peacemakers and endure persecution. Not exactly the way to gain a following. But Jesus tells us that these are the ones whom God will truly bless.

Jesus then challenges His listeners, and us today, by proclaiming that we are the "salt of the earth" and "the light of the world". Wow! Are His expectations too high? I don't think so. It's not as if we overtly strive to be salt and light. It is simply a fact that if we live godly Christian lives; put into practice the "beatitudes", we will by nature be salt and light to the world around us.

Then we looked at the section where we said that Jesus "replaced" the bar of righteousness. It's not enough to not murder, we should not even be angry. It's not enough to not commit adultery, we shouldn't even lust. It's not enough to divorce legally, we should stay married. It's not enough to technically not lie, we should always be upfront and truthful. It's not enough to retaliate proportionally, we should not retaliate at all. And, it's not enough to love your neighbors, we should love our enemies as well. Yes, that's placing the bar where God has always intended it.

Then we saw where Jesus tells us that it's not enough to do the right thing, but we must do it for the right reasons. Motives matter.

Sunday, we will discuss where our heart and treasure is. Hope to see you!
