“Spur One Another On”

“Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is his body, and since we have a great high priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

The third of the five “let us” statements found in Hebrews 10 says, “Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.” Inherent in this statement is the responsibility that we have to consider each other. Yes, I am ultimately responsible for my own salvation and relationship with God. However, we each have a responsibility to one another to encourage, strengthen and help each other as we strive together to serve God. The writer says that we need to “consider” how to do this. This means that encouraging (spurring) is a calculated effort. It means that I should have you in my thoughts and prayers. It means that I should be consciously thinking about ways to encourage you and vice versa.

As a part of a somewhat large church family, it is easy for people and their needs to go unnoticed. It is up to each of us to be looking around and noticing others. We need to have eyes like Jesus who always seemed to notice those who were hurting.

“Spurring” may not sound enjoyable, especially to the “spurred”! But there are times when each of us needs a kick in the pants to get our attention. Of course this must be done as gently as possible and with the most sincere of motives. It also shows the importance of having a relationship with each other. I am going to be much more receptive to you spurring me if you have already shown that you love me and are genuinely concerned about my spiritual walk.

So yes, we need to encourage each other. And yes, sometimes we need to spur each other. But at all times we need to be considering each other.
